- Sight for Students is a VSP charity that provides free vision exams and glasses to low-income, uninsured children. The program operates nationally through a network of community partners who identify children in need and VSP network doctors who provide the eye care services.
- Qualifications:
  1. Family income is no more than 200% of federal poverty level
  2. Services are not available for any item already covered by insurance including coverage through a government program.
  3. Child is 19 years old or younger and has not graduated from high school.
  4. Social security number.
  5. Child has not used the Sight for Students program during the past 12 months.
  6. Sight for Students gift certificates are distributed through community partners to children who qualify.
